Additions to the Existing Camp Rules

July 13 - 16, 2010

Due to some new insurance policies regarding the Camp we must add some new rules to The Camp's already existing rules. These rules have different reasons for being added, some because of fire regulation, some because of the "bullying" situations we have seen across our country, but most are to protect all of us from potentially hurtful situations.

These new rules are to be read over and discussed with your child, and then you and the child will sign and bring the document with you to Camp on registration day. Please make sure to do this as it will ensure a speedy registration. Without the signed paper we will have to have you read and sign before the Camper will be signed in.

These rules are in no particular order, but there are all of equal importances.

1. **Please leave Cell phones at home.** You can live without them for 4 days. If there is a specific need for the cell phone that should be discussed with Cap. Cap's number is the emergency number for all parents. 978.660.0924. Parents do not call your child concerning family issues or weather situations. Please call Cap first and she will have the Camper contact you with an adult present.
2. Those Campers receiving the permission for Cell phones may only use them during their free time. At no time should they be used during sectionals or formal practice sessions. They should not be used to contact other Campers. **They are not allowed to be used after 11pm.** At this time the chaperons will collect all phones and keep them in their rooms until the next day. They will be charged at that time.
3. Should a Camper be found with a cell phone that does not have permission to have it, it will be confiscated and returned to the parent after the Friday night performance. Please have your name on your cell phone.
4. Absolutely no type of Bullying or Harassing will be allowed. That means face to face, through passing of notes, or group teasing. This is a zero tolerance situation. You bully, you get caught, YOU GO HOME!
5. **Social gatherings:** Campers may gather in all the common areas. That would be the great rooms of all cottages, porches, the quad, and dinning room.
6. **There is no member of the opposite sex allowed in the sleep areas or hallways.**
7. No more than 3 people in any given dorm room. (fire regulation)
8. No members of the opposite sex in each other's room.
9. No PDA! Ask your parents what that means if you don't know. This year we have a good number of Campers that are dating each other. Keep your hands to yourselves.
10. At all times be respectful of all the chaperons, instructors, fellow campers and staff. This includes The Incarnation staff and the grounds.
